
How can we support you

We will work with you to identify and build on your strengths and to work towards solutions.




This service is available for families and their children in the Huntly area who are enrolled with Plunket.

Plunket Family Workers are employed by Family Works and accountable to a Family Works Service Manager and the Plunket Clinical Leader.
