Childhood should be a safe and happy experience

When home no longer feels safe and families break apart, it's shattering and painful for everyone. Children and young people are particularly vulnerable. The impact on them can last a lifetime.

These things can destroy families and harm children and young people:

- · family violence
- emotional or psychological abuse
- neglect
- · alcohol or drug use
- physical or mental health issues
- poverty
- traumatic life events
- grief and loss
- · bullying.

Family Works counsellors have the skills and experience to support children and young people when the problems are too big to handle on their own.

Children and young people can be referred by a family member, doctor, school, or social worker. Those at secondary school or older can ask for help themselves.

The service is free and confidential – no one else needs to know except you and your family.

What abuse looks like

Abuse is when someone...

- ... hits, punches or kicks people
- ... touches a person's body without permission
- ... puts a person down, calls them names or bullies them
- ... neglects to look after their family properly
- ... hurts others in the family.

Each child or young person will react differently to abuse. Some become withdrawn while others grow aggressive and disruptive.

Whatever their outward behaviour, abuse is likely to seriously hinder a child's or young person's development and destroy their wellbeing.
